KEY CHARACTERISTICS: A “disciple-making” ministry...

- ...offers Different Invitations
- ...offers Different Phases
- ...offers careful use of Resources
- ...offers Progressive Information & Training.
- ...requires a Cost
- ...assumes Change & Flexibility
- ...assumes Duplication

A “disciple-making” ministry... bases its work on the fact that people are at Different levels on their spiritual journey.

A “disciple-making” ministry is one that can minister to people at their spiritual level or interest!

A “philosophy of ministry” will determine...

what is **Important** where we spend our **Resources**, & how we **Interpret** life inside & outside of our Christian family.

MINISTRY LEVELS:

BUILD

Ministry: using your life to make a **spiritual** impact in someone else’s life.

Invitation: Come & **Grow**

Maturity/Interest: Convinced Learner

Goal: to help people grow in their relationship to Jesus Christ.

EQUIP

Invitation: Come & **Serve**

Maturity/Interest: Committed Worker

Goal: to train people to do the ministry.

Workers need to be...

Faithful – **Available** – **Teachable**

A worker has a servant’s heart & a teachable spirit!

As we **Serve**, we train.

SEND

Invitation: Come & **Lead**

Maturity/Interest: Create **Leaders**

Goal: to duplicate ministry leaders.

CHRISTIAN RANK & TITLES:

Servant & **Servant** Leader

WIN

Invitation: Come & **See**

Maturity/Interest: Curious **Seekers**

Goal: to designed to expose people to Jesus Christ in a positive way and have them either **accept** or go away **closer** to accepting Him.
